The CMIA By laws are attached below.

The CMIB is a legislatively directed chartered public benfit corporation

under the Harbors and Navigation Code and is of course tax exempt.



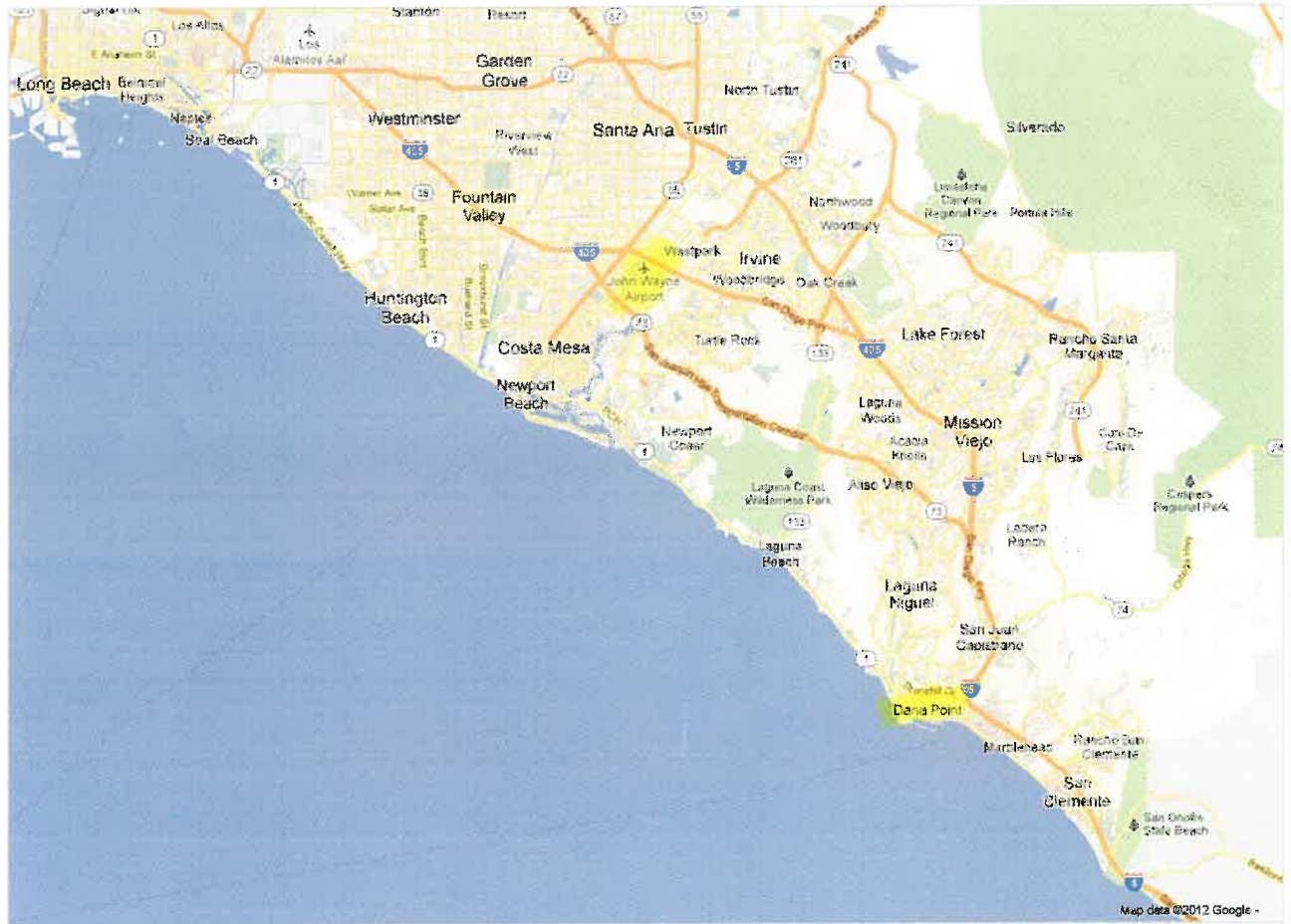
